

"Cry Baby" Jaskowiak was assigned by corrupt judge Weilheimer only 3 days after ex-sister, Jsh and her sister camp filed their petition for guardianship on Mother in mid May 2021. Why so fast? Mother or anyone had the right to hire their own lawyer if they had the money to do so. The mafia knew Mother had about \$2 million in assets because of what Jsh had told them. He knew those federal and state laws and rules for the incapacitated AND the PA Rules of Conduct for lawyers. But, Cry Baby always ignored them for his and the mafia's financial benefit.

Cry Baby admitted he only saw Mother twice in her 3 years being owned by the mafia. Why only 2? She was his client. Mother was denied a phone to ever call him. He ignored the PA Rules of Conduct for Lawyers. His obligation was to serve his client, NOT himself and his personal needs and wants. Cry Baby refused to let Mother come to court to ever speak for herself or to fire Cry Baby. But, Cry Baby filed and replied to petitions in behalf of Mother without talking to her and asking what she wanted. Even though she was claimed to be "incapacitated" (by Quack Ledakis), Mother still had the right to make decisions and to demand what she wanted be carried out. Even Quack Ledakis had said Mother would have no problems being in court. Why was she denied? Because she would be able to clearly and logically explain what SHE wanted, thus leaving the ownership of the mafia, along with Mother's vast assets.

The letter Mother wrote (in her own well-written handwriting) to Weilheimer in about April 2022 wanting to come to court to speak, go back home, a new lawyer to replace Cry Baby and for me to live with her, was denied by Weilheimer ONLY because Quack Ledakis claimed in another "evaluation" (by order of Weilheimer) of Mother that Mother did not know what she was writing. Weilheimer had demanded Ledakis do another evaluation to decide if Mother wrote her letter on her own. Ledakis claimed Mother did not write the letter on her own and that I told her what to write. But, as usual, Ledakis NEVER recorded his session with Mother to PROVE what Mother said or did not say OR did he ever meet with her. WTF?.

It is very interesting that in a group phone conference of lawyers and me in about March 2022, Cry Baby said he recently saw Mother at the pig pen and she said she liked her room, liked the people and liked the food. SO, Cry Baby is saying Mother had the mind and logic to know what she liked and wanted.

SO, a month later, when Mother wrote her letter, she also KNEW what she wanted in her letter. Cry Baby admitted she did by what he said in the phone conference. Gotcha Cry Baby!
