

My letter to the assistant to Judge Del Ricci on august 30 2021 about the scam on my Mother .
Del Ricci was the president judge at the time. He never did anything.

Dear Samantha,

I will be sending a long letter pertaining to the situation involving my 96 year old mother and the recent decision by the Orphans Court to have her declared totally incapacitated. As matters have progressed, she was removed from her house last Wednesday and being forced to live with her 70 year old daughter who she does not like or feel close to. I am not allowed to see or talk to my mother and I do not know why. I am refused answers. I was told on Friday by Judge Weilheimer that "visitations" are being arranged. Why? I have not done anything wrong. My mother and I have had a extremely close and loving relationship. I got rid of my house three months ago because my mother wanted me to move into her large house. Now, her court appointed guardian is telling me I have only three weeks left to move out of the house. Why? he won't tell me. Is he going to sell her house and junk her valuable contents and put her into a nursing home? She has lived in her house for 21 years. She is fully capable to live on her own. she is NOT incapacitated as the court defines it. Facts prove that. She does have about a 20% or so instant recall/memory issue. Until three months ago, she still drove her car without any problems.

Because I did not have the money any longer to continue to have the lawyer I hired to be sure my mother's court appointed lawyer was doing what he should be, I had to be pro se in court. As a 41 year investigator doing lie detection, I had documents and questions to ask in court. But, as pro se, I was treated then and still treated now by Judge Weilheimer as if I was a nobody. Many times she yelled at me in court and refused to allow me to ask many important questions.

This is about the future happiness of my mother. I would like to have a meeting with Judge Del Ricci to discuss this serious matter for the benefit of my mother.
