

Corrupt and pretend "judge" demorat weilheimer

Corrupt and pretend "judge" weilheimer, best friend of lorie Shapiro (wife of PA governor josh Shapiro) was the first corrupt judge of my Mother's ownership. The mafia claimed it was a guardianship by the guardian mafia. About early 2023, Josh Shapiro had nominated weilheimer to be a US district judge and it was approved by biden. Weilheimer's husband is vice president and chief counsel for the liberal newspaper Philadelphia Inquirer. That is why there have been no stories published about the corruption of the orphans court and its many judges (past and present) in Montgomery county because weilheimer's husband kills any such stories. Many of its reporters have tried to do those stories of orphans court corruption, but those stories were always killed by weilheimer's husband.

About mid 2023, gail weilheimer had been approved to be a US district judge and was replaced by another corrupt judge, sterling. Sterling also refused to ever allow the facts that proved Mother's ownership by the mafia was fake and to send Mother back to her massive, beautiful home in a gated community so Mother could enjoy the rest of her life. Instead, sterling wanted to keep Mother's assets for the mafia, just like weilheimer ignored those same facts of Mother's innocence of incapacitation.

Twice, weilheimer allowed contempt of court charges against me, started by cry baby jaskowiak, because I was exposing the mafia's corruption on Mother in my news website: Protectmyparents.us. Both times, cry baby charged mother and me about \$5,000 for his "time" filing those fake contempts just to make himself and the mafia more money. Jaskowiak NEVER consulted Mother, his client, if she wanted him to do so, especially since both times I would be sent to prison for several months.

The first contempt trial was in December 2021. I was pro se. At no time, since prison would be a punishment in both contempts, did I get a public defender or a jury trial that I was entitled. First guardian of person and estate logie was there and he brought his lawyer zabowski and both charged Mother for their "time", even though neither of them had to be there. Weilheimer, cry baby, and zabowski ignored the fact that my news website was protected by the First Admendment and none of them ever asked Mother if she wanted the contempt. I was found guilty and weilheimer sentenced me to 6 months in prison or until I took the information down from the website. They all laughed because they knew there are no computers in prison to delete the information and I would be in prison and unable to stop their stealing for 6 months. But, my IT friend was able to do it and I was released after about 2 months. Weilheimer issued a order that said I could not tell my Mother I was ever in prison. Not surprised because Mother would have the ability to fire cry baby jaskowiak and demand a new lawyer to help her go home.

The second contempt in about early 2022 was again by cry baby because I had a link to the old website version on my revised website version. Cry baby claimed I violated my release by having the link. He demanded I demand Google, which keeps all websites in "storage" forever and refuses to delete them, delete the old version from its storage. Again, I was found guilty by weilheiler. But, weilheimer lied in her ruling. She had said if I paid jaskowik another \$5,000, I would not go to prison. I paid him, but she sent me to prison for about 2 more months anyway.

WTF? In October 2019, cry baby and 2 other lawyers made a 3 hour video for lawyers about guardianship. Cry baby bragged he uses contempt of court in case to get his way, to make money and to send people to prison. Cry baby certainly told the "truth" in that video of what he does. What he does is called lawfare, using the courts as a weapon. Weilheimer also knows that. Lawfare is banned in courts by honest judges.

In early 2024, cry baby filed another contempt of court against me because one of the mafia's hired monitors (paid liars), mary ellen, claimed I videotaped Mother during a visit against weilheimers previous orders. Sterling was the new judge. Cry baby lost big because I proved mary ellen had lied about what she saw. Did cry baby get paid by Mother for his time, like before, to create the contempt and be in court that day?

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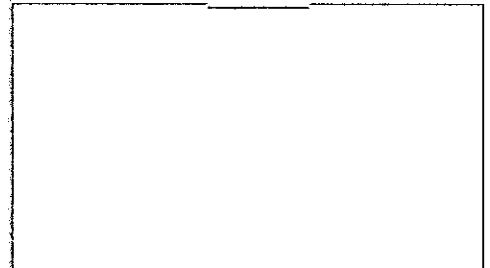


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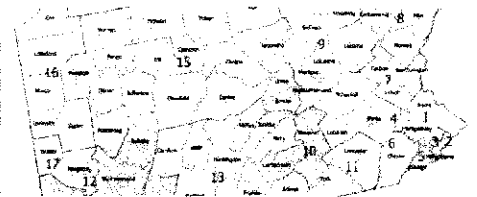
Weilheimer Nominated For U.S. District Court For Eastern District of PA

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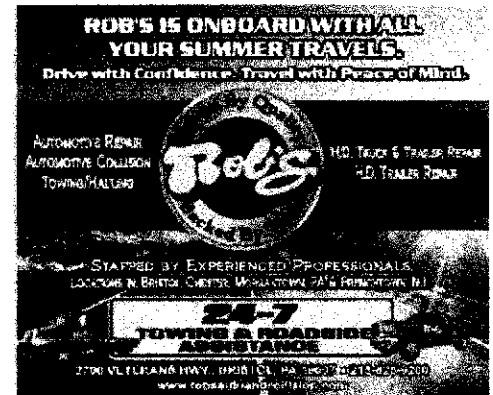

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Pennsylvania's U.S. Senators have a longstanding tradition of working together to recommend and confirm nominees to the federal bench. Senator Casey previously worked with then-Senators **Arlen Specter** and **Pat Toomey**, with whom he confirmed 37 District Court Judges for Pennsylvania on a bipartisan basis from 2007-2022. Casey and Fetterman have continued this practice, most recently working together to recommend and confirm **Judge Julia Munley** and **Judge Karoline Mehalchick** in the Middle District.

Weilheimer has been a judge on the Montgomery County Court of Common Pleas in Norristown, Pennsylvania since 2014. Previously, Weilheimer worked as a senior counsel at Wisler Pearlstine, LLP in Blue Bell, Pennsylvania from 2006 to 2013 and as a litigation associate at Frank & Rosen LLP in Elkins Park, Pennsylvania from 2003 to 2006. From 2004 to 2008, Weilheimer served as an elected Commissioner for Abington Township, Pennsylvania. In 2002, Weilheimer worked as an associate at Abrahams, Loewenstein and Bushman, P.C. in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Before that, she served as an Assistant District Attorney in the Philadelphia District Attorney's Office from 1995 to 2002. Weilheimer received her J.D. in 1995 and her B.A. in 1992, both from Hofstra University.
