

JSH FILES FAKE REPORT OF ABUSE TO POLICE

On February 24, 2020, jsh went to the Franconia police (where mother lived) and filed a report claiming I had kicked jsh in the back. Jsh never told either Mother or me she had done so. The police, in their stupidity as investigators, never contacted me to ask my side of the story. Jsh said she did not want to press charges.

Very interesting because at the petition hearing on July 2021, jsh claimed I tried to push her down the steps, but never mentioned anything about the so-called kicking incident.

Also, the day Mother was kidnapped, logie had contacted that police department and they had 2 of their cops holding me on the porch while jsh went in the house and dragged mother to jsh's car. The cops refused to tell me what was going on. While being held, I heard mother screaming "I don't want to go" many times.

Only 2 days later, jsh had taken Mother to her regular hairdresser of 16 years. The hair dresser told me Mother was shaking and crying saying "I want to go home, I want to go home". Mother would be drugged and starved by jsh at jsh's house to the point of Mother becoming unconscious and had to be taken to the hospital by ambulance and confined to bed for 6 weeks and treated for starvation.

She said her brother, Author Herring, pushed her and kicked her in the back while inside the home. She said her brother is a violent person and is trying to manipulate his way into their mother's home. Jill said her mother suffers from mild dementia. Jill said she has limited power of attorney on her mother's finances, but not full power attorney over her mother. Jill thinks her brother is trying to move in with their mother to take over power of attorney and steal money. She also added her brother threatened her not to come back onto their mother's property. During my conversation with Jill, I asked her if she wanted something done about being assaulted by her brother this past weekend. Jill said that she did not want to pursue any charges, but wanted a report on file. Jill and I spoke for a while and I advised her the best course of action for her was to hire an attorney to help with the power of attorney. I also added that she needs to call immediately if her brother assaulted her again. I also told Jill that her mother owned the property and it was up to her to have who she wanted on the property and not her brother. Jill understood and will look into an attorney to assist her and will call if our department is needed further.
