ORDER

AND NOW, this 10th day of June, 2021, following a request of counsel for the alleged incapacitated person, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Dr. George Ledakis is **appointed** to perform a neuro-psychological evaluation of the capacity of Jane T. Herring, which shall meet the requirements of 20 Pa. C.S. §5518, with such evaluation to be retrospective to January 1, 2020 to the present. The Court directs that this evaluation be completed on or before July 6, 2021 or notice be given to the Court if this cannot be done. Dr. Ledakis is directed to submit his report to the Honorable Gail Weilheimer and to David A. Jaskowiak, Esquire, counsel for the alleged incapacitated person.

It is hereby **FURTHER ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Dr. Ledakis shall be given full and unfettered access by family members to the alleged incapacitated person for the purpose of completing this evaluation. Dr. Ledakis is also authorized to access any and all medical information pertaining to the alleged incapacitated person, including from her physicians, medical providers and other individuals who may have information which Dr. Ledakis deems relevant and necessary to his assessment. The failure to abide of any party to honor this Order may lead to contempt proceeding and the imposition of sanctions. See Pa. O.C. Rule 14.7(b)(2).
